Commentary

The highest human potential is to realize our Oneness with God as our very Self. In the Sai Satcharita and other Scriptures such as the Duet of One, they talk about how acquiring knowledge is helpful for seekers, but isn't as relevant for those who are established in their relationship with God and their identity as the Self with an individualized self. At that point, what else is there to know? The Ocean knows all the waves. While we continue to express our individualities interacting with the other waves, good/bad, positive/negative, we can simultaneously appreciate the Actor playing all the roles.
